Note:

The private economy might as well be reflected with a graph such as this. In which case, we might be better able to visualize its priorities.

Primary & Auxiliary Public Goods

A big qualification for where an industry lies upon the spectrum, is whether or not people would engage in an activity of natural necessity or of their own free will. Obviously, then, accessing food and water are of paramount concern. After that, would an individual or group not educate or train their offspring? Art and recreation come after these demands have been satisfied. Housing as a part of infrastructure is paramount next. Sanitation then upon further housing, as a city would demand. Energy comes next, and on down the line, industries becoming progressively more abstract; as the scale slides, the purpose behind an industry is that of support. General Priority, and thus funding, ought to reflect these roles.



Funding Primary Goods

Healthy, happy people who are knowledgable in many, many things. People have been doing these things without external incentive for thousands of years. They are the best part of the human spirit. They are more "us" than the supporting industries. Less abstract, more real. Enjoyable, healthy, rewarding. People do these things because they love them. Result in heaps of rewards for all, and by hardly trying.

Funding Auxiliary Goods

People often dislike their work. Find it hard to see what good they do. Abstract, hazy rewards. Must know extremely particular object. Cogs in machines, building more and more tools for less and less a purpose. Monetized education and food and art devalue themselves through that very monetization; sold to the lowest bidder. Reduces intrinsic incentive, requiring further monetary cycling to arrive at funding primary functions. Tools only here. No plans. No futures. Must be secondary. Without primary guidance, these functions are meaningless. Full priority to auxiliary functions will end badly.
